nine women age 75 or older, and one in five age 85 or older, needs assistance with daily activities⁵ The Ability to Pay for Long-Term Care Long-term care services can be costly In 2006, the average annual cost of a private room in a nursing home was \$75,000; for a shared room, almost \$67,000 Costs for home care average nearly \$20 per hour⁶
